WINERY DATA

Case Production: 4,000. Acres Owned: 41 acres in Napa Valley. Varietals by Acre: Cabernet Franc (1 acre), Cabernet Sauvignon (28), Petit Verdot (1), Sauvignon Blanc (5), Syrah (5), Viognier (1).

Since the 1970s, Eisele Vineyard, situated at the foot of the Palisades mountains southeast of Calistoga, has proven to be one of California's greatest vineyards, with a distinguished track record for yielding consistently excellent, distinctive and ageworthy wines. In years such as 1974 (under the Conn Creek label), 1975, 1978, 1979, and 1985, the wines have shown uncommon richness, with thick, chewy, earthy tannins and a complex core of currant, berry and mineral flavors. They are also amazingly ageworthy, keeping their youthful, vibrant personalities for up to two decades.

The vineyard was originally planted by Milt and Barbara Eisele. In 1990, the Eiseles sold it to Bart and Daphne Araujo, who have continued to make genuinely sensational wines. The Araujos undertook a major overhaul, replanting many vines, adding new grape varieties (Petit Verdot, Syrah, Sangiovese, Sauvignon Blanc, and Viognier), building a handsome new winery and aging caves. Along with the superb Cabernet, the winery makes a small amount of equally stunning Syrah (500 cases) and a very fine Sauvignon Blanc.

TASTING NOTES

CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY EISELE VINEYARD (****): Magnificent Cabernet, easily among the finest. Uniformly dark and rich with complex, concentrated fruit flavors and supple, polished tannins, marked by a characteristic mineral edge. Ages exceptionally well.

SYRAH NAPA VALLEY EISELE VINEYARD (****): This wine shares the Cabernet's power and finesse, with rich, thick, earthy currant and meaty flavors. No track record yet for aging, but it has all the right stuff. Limited production makes it hard to get.
